

Grace Church Transportation Policy

The following guidelines are designed to assure that safe transportation of people to and from activities sponsored by Grace Episcopal Church, Baldwinsville, and requiring transportation off church ground.

1. Vehicles used to transport participants shall be licensed vehicles which have successfully passed New York State inspection, are currently registered in New York, and have a recommended liability insurance of \$100,000 to \$300,000.
2. All requirements according to New York State law with respect to seatbelts and their use shall be adhered to.
3. The number of persons being transported in a passenger vehicle shall not exceed the number of seatbelts installed in the automobile. Each person shall have a seatbelt and be required to use it.
4. Any commercial vehicle used for transportation of passengers shall be operated in compliance with New York State law relative to the use of seatbelts.
5. Drivers must be at least 21 years old and possess a valid New York State operator's license.
6. The driver shall at all times obey the Motor Vehicle laws of the State of New York and shall not transport people while he/she is under the influence of alcohol or any other substance which might impair his/her ability to function in the best interests of the safety of his/her passengers.
7. All persons under the age of 18 years of age shall have a permission slip signed by a parent or legal guardian granting permission to go on the trip and to be transported by the church group.
8. This policy must be reviewed by the Vestry before July 1 of each year.
